- CSCF Development Level - Certified. Development Level Trained may be considered depending upon experience
- 5+ years of general ski coaching experience - Proven track record of developing successful athletes
- Personal high level competition experience an asset
- Must be a team player able to work well and communicate with other members of a larger coaching team
- Should possess the ability to deal with parents, athletes, coaches and other stakeholders patiently, firmly, fairly and diplomatically
- Should be an achiever who is goal oriented, sets high standards and who has a high level of personal energy and stamina

### **Responsibilities**

Support the Head Coach to implement the U14 program by:

- Developing and delivering daily lesson plans based on the focus of each block of training;
- Adapting plans to suit the environment, conditions and the athlete's abilities;
- Ensuring a safe training and competition environment for all athletes while delivering the content in a fun and creative way;
- Taking ownership of the athletes' development;
- Keeping up to date training journals and completing mid term and year end report cards for athletes;
- Assisting in course setting as needed;
- Ensuring all athletes are abiding by the NASA Code of Conduct;
- Ensuring all PART issued equipment is maintained and operational throughout the season; and
- Understanding the full NASA program and its structure; actively promote the Club to internal and external parties.
