The Position:

Reporting to the Head Coach, the successful candidate will have extensive coaching / technical qualifications, experience providing strength & conditioning training, strong communication and presentation skills, and a talent for administration and organization.

This exciting opportunity will provide the successful candidate opportunities for growth and development in high-performance coaching, while working with our team of top-level coaching staff. ACA also offers competitive compensation and benefits based upon eligibility.

Duties:

- Work in conjunction with all team coaches to design, implement, and monitor annual training and competition plan.
- Assist in record-keeping of all collected data.
- Monitor Athlete's equipment needs and liaise proactively with the equipment representatives.
- Provide assistance to oversee maintenance and control of team equipment.
- Provide timely and effective communication to Athletes, Coaches, and Alpine Canada Alpin.
