The Okanagan Ski Team is in need of an assistant FIS coach for the 2021-2022 ski season . The team is based out of Kelowna, BC with most training taking place at Apex mountain. The assistant coach will work full time through the contract period and will be expected to travel with the team to numerous events on our race schedule.

Terms and Conditions

The candidate will hold the position of OST Assistant Coach for the 2021/2022 season, and in this capacity will be accountable and report to the OST Head Coach. The coaching services will include assisting the Head Coach to plan and implement on-snow coaching suitable and appropriate for a competitive alpine ski club program consistent with the safety constraints and harassment policy laid down by the BC Alpine Ski Association. Coaching services will be performed in accordance with the OST Code of Conduct and governed by the Canadian Ski Coaches Federation Coaching Code of Ethics and will include these responsibilities, skills and abilities:

Athlete Responsibilities

- Promote the technical / physiological / psychological / emotional development of all athletes in the OST program
- Ensure a “Safe” and “Fun” environment and provide a positive “Role Model” for athletes and their families
- Promote a love for the sport of alpine ski racing and alpine skiing
- Promote the values of “Fair Play” and provide equal treatment for all athletes

Organizational Responsibilities

- Be both timely and efficient regarding all organizational procedures during daily training and race events.
- Manage and maintain all equipment in your charge; i.e. radios, drills, cameras etc.

General Responsibilities

- Create an atmosphere of cooperation and support for the OST through positive interaction with OST parents and all ski area employees
- Promote membership retention and recruitment at all levels of the OST
- Perform all other related duties as required by the Head Coach
