



## Mount Allan Ski Team Association U12 Head Coach

The Mount Allan Ski Team Association (MAST) is a member club of the Nakiska Alpine Ski Association (NASA) located in Calgary, AB, with primary training at the Nakiska Ski Resort. NASA consists of 5 independent ski clubs comprising 250+ athletes and 40+ coaches. Working in conjunction with the other NASA member clubs, NASTC is committed to delivering an athletic program to Canada's most promising and dedicated FIS skiers so they can attain their maximum individual athletic potential. Our goal is to raise the bar in the standard of athlete and ski racer development while keeping the cost of the sport accessible to as many families as possible.

Reporting to the Program Director, the U12 Head Coach plays a key role in developing our young talent and providing our U14 Team with athletes possessing solid technical base, tactical knowledge, work ethic, discipline, passion, and desire to improve and compete.

MAST is seeking a U12 Head Coach for the 2021-22 season, September to April.

### Responsibilities

Under the direction of the Program Director, lead a nation leading U12 program by:

- Implementing seasonal dryland program in coordination with NASA Strength and Conditioning specialist.
- In coordination with PD, hire U12 coaching staff.
- Providing annual on-hill safety training to U12 coaching staff.
- Leading a large team of assistant coaches and provide technical direction to the U12 staff.
- Managing U12 coach work schedules, including substitute coaches as needed.
- Ensuring administrative duties are current, including submitting payroll, TeamSnap updates, incident reports.
- Keeping up to date training journals, attendance records and completing report cards for all athletes.
- Attending all PSO lead coach meetings and seminars related to U12 programs.
- Designing & implementing daily on-snow lesson plans.
- Ensuring a safe training and race environment for athletes and coaches.
- Taking ownership of the athletes' development.
- Course setting as needed to meet the daily objectives.
- Ensuring all athletes are abiding by the NASA Code of Conduct.
- Ability to travel for competitions required. Some weekday (daytime) availability required.

### Qualifications and Characteristics

- 5+ years' general ski coaching experience or 2+ years' experience coaching at U14 or higher.
- Minimum ACA DL-Trained & CSIA 1.
- DL-Certified an asset. CSIA Level 2 an asset.
- Degree in Education, Kinesiology, Physical Literacy or related field an asset.
- Class 4 Alberta driver's licence. Needs to be valid by Dec 01, 2021.
- Proven track record of developing successful athletes.
- Strong understanding and knowledge of the ACA LTD plan.
- Team player, able to work well and communicate with other members of a larger coaching team.
- Experience working effectively with parents, athletes, and coaches with high level of diplomacy.
- Skill development oriented, highly motivated and holds self and others to a high standard.
- High level of energy, stamina, professionalism, and dedication
- Personal high level ski racing experience an asset
