FIS Registration Procedures

ALBERTA ALPINE

2015 - 2016 Season

Please see the following information regarding the FIS registration procedures for the upcoming season. Registration should flow from the clubs to Alberta Alpine and then onto Alpine Canada. All of the necessary athlete forms can be found in the Registration section of the Alberta Alpine website.

The initial registration information should be entered on the Zone 4 online registration system. Please be aware of the following registration deadlines and costs. The deadlines refer to the electronic registration and payment being received. **All paperwork (originals only, no faxes) to be submitted to the Alberta Alpine office by Thursday, August 20, 2015 or late fees will be incurred.**

FIS licenses run from July 1 to June 30 every year. Although the registration deadline is August 20, if an athlete intends to train, dryland train, or race prior to August 20, they should be registered by June 24 in order to activate their license by July 1.

It is the responsibility of the athlete to ensure their name appears on the FIS site (<http://www.fis-ski.com>) with active status well before their first FIS race.

All forms should be handed into your club then the club will submit as one package.

Registration Checklist:

- Zone 4 Online Registration via your club registrar
- ACA Registration Form
- FIS Athlete Declaration (New FIS Athletes Only)
- ACA Medical Evaluation – requires a visit to a doctor
- Canada West Release Form – **must be printed in colour and filled out completely, incl initials in 3 spots.** **This is an **application** only.
- Canada West Digital Photo – see instruction sheet
- Canadian FIS Card Only Form (only Canadian FIS card registrants will submit this form)
- CCES Protocol for Listed Athletes-notified separately if you fall within 50 points of the leader
