## FIS REGISTRATION PACKAGE 2015—16 SEASON

Online registration is required  
through your home club

Any clubs that are unsure of the online registration process, please contact Member Services at the Alberta Alpine office for directions and access to the system.

### IMPORTANT

*Individuals must register directly with their club not with Alberta Alpine.  
Always default to your club's guidelines which may have earlier timelines, different costs and requirements than we list here.*

### MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION OF FIS ATHLETES:

1. FIS registrations must come from an Alberta Alpine member club, not directly to the Alberta Alpine office.
2. Registrants must be Canadian citizens.
3. Athlete must be a member in good standing with Alberta Alpine with no outstanding payments due to any of our member clubs.
4. Club registrar has submitted all pertinent information on line through the Zone 4 registration system previous to forwarding paperwork.
5. All original copies (ink on paper) of completed early registration Forms must be at Alberta Alpine office by August 20, 2015

### IMPORTANT THINGS TO CONSIDER:

- A. The FIS Medical Form requires a visit to your doctor's office, which generally will incur additional costs and should be booked ASAP to avoid delays and a potential late fee.
- B. LATE and IMMEDIATE REGISTRATION FEES HAVE GONE UP CONSIDERABLY. Any registrations that do not have paperwork in to the Alberta Alpine office by August 20 deadline will be automatically assessed the "Late Registration" fee.
- C. If the member is not properly registered by their club online, the membership forms will not be accepted by Alberta Alpine.
- D. It is the responsibility of the athlete to ensure their name appears on the FIS site with active status prior to their first FIS race.
- E. Faxed, emailed or scanned forms will not be accepted under any circumstance.

### CANCELLATION POLICY:

*FIS Registrations may be cancelled by Oct 15th but will be subject to a \$95.00 cancellation fee. After Oct 15th membership may not be cancelled or refunded.. Alberta Alpine must be informed by email ([memberservices@albertaalpine.ca](mailto:memberservices@albertaalpine.ca)) of all requests to remove a FIS registration. Alberta Alpine has no control over FIS deadlines or late fees.*

### DISCIPLINE SELECTION:

FIS Athletes may select to be either Alpine, SkiCross or both. A member registering in both disciplines only pays the insurance, national competitor card and Alberta Alpine membership costs once, but receives competitor card numbers and active registration in both FIS Freestyle and FIS Alpine disciplines.

**TIMELINES:** Registration starts on June 4, 2015. Costs will increase after August 20, 2015.

### CANADA WEST PASS - REGISTER EARLY:

Meeting the registration deadline of August 20, 2015 is the best way to ensure eligibility for a Canada West Pass, however the paperwork is an application only. Passes will be awarded based on availability.

### PRICING: (standard rate, discount rate rates are available—see below)

- \$ 740 Alpine or SX International \*Nat Card included
  - \$ 835 Dual (Alp and SX) International \*Nat Card incl.
  - \$456 Canadian FIS Card. NO racing outside Canada.
  - \$556 Canadian Dual (Alp and SX) NO racing outside Can.
- \*\*Costs increase considerably after Aug 20 for both late and immediate activation fees.**

### REQUIRED FORMS—All New This Year:

1. FIS Athlete Declaration (\*\*First year FIS athletes only)
2. ACA Registration Form
3. ACA Medical Evaluation Form (*requires visiting a physician*)
4. Canadian Only FIS Form (*for athletes who plan to race in FIS events within Canada only*)
