Policy Title

Alberta Alpine Ski Association Officials Code of Conduct Policy

Policy Objective

An individual who registers as an Official member of the Alberta Alpine Ski Association and accepts the responsibility associated with a position at an alpine ski racing competition sanctioned by the Alberta Alpine Ski Association (all disciplines and types) agrees to accept the responsibilities as outlined to them, and will complete the duties for the agreed to period.

Procedure

The role of Official is critical to the success of any activity and in carrying out the assigned responsibilities, each Official is expected to:

- 1. Refrain from using tobacco products within the competition area and only in designated areas if such are provided.
- 2. Refrain from entering the competition area under the influence of alcohol.
- 3. Refrain from the use of profane, insulting, harassing or otherwise offensive language in the conduct of his/her duties.
- 4. Be fully prepared to do the assigned job.
- 5. Arrive in good time for the competition and report immediately to the official in charge.
- 6. Draw all the necessary equipment for the responsibilities and duties assigned and ensure that all such is returned upon completion of the event.
- 7. Conduct the event according to the rules with the welfare of the athlete in mind and do the job in an efficient and nonabrasive manner.
- 8. Work in a spirit of cooperation with other officials and do not interfere in any way with their duties and responsibilities.
- 9. Extend the benefit of your experience to the less experienced officials whenever the opportunity arises.
- 10. Criticize only in a constructive manner and only at an appropriate time and directly to the official concerned.
- 11. Give evaluations, when requested, in an objective manner.
- 12. Act in a manner that will bring credit to the Alpine Community and yourself, both within and outside the competition arena and/or area.
- 13. Respect the athletes' dignity; Verbal or physical behaviors that constitute harassment or abuse are unacceptable. (Please refer to the AASA Athletics Harassment Policy)
- 14. Never advocate or condone the use of drugs or other banned performance enhancing substances, classes or methods.
- 15. Never provide under age athletes with alcohol.
