- Follow and acknowledge Club policies including R.I.S.E (Respect.Inclusion.Support.Effort), and Emergency Action Plan
- Helmets are mandatory
- Team Jackets provided

Entry Level Coach Qualifications:

- Must be 16 years or older
- Minimum Entry Level trained status or willing to complete Entry Level course
- Entry Level Certified, CSIA levels considered an asset
- Team player and gets along well with others and can communicate with team mates
- Communicate well with children and can pass on feedback to parents
- High energy, resilience, professionalism, willing to continue your coaching education
- Past alpine racer U16 and higher considered an asset
