- Drive team van to training and competition venues as needed.
- Deliver dryland training program as outlined by Head Coach and S&C coach.
- Ensuring all KAST issued equipment is maintained and operational throughout the season; and
- Understand the full NASA program and its structure; actively promote the Club to internal and external parties.

- 3+ years' general ski coaching experience or 2+ years' experience coaching at U16 or higher.
- ACA Development Level Certified minimum certification, Performance Level Trained/Certified an asset.
- Personal high-level competition experience an asset.
- Valid Alberta class 4 drivers license or willingness to obtain.
- Experience working effectively with parents, athletes, coaches and other stakeholders.
- Good technical and tactical knowledge of the LTAD plan
- Team player able to work well and communicate with other members of a larger coaching team
