Re: ACA Fee Increases for 2023-24 Season

Dear Membership,

Alberta Alpine has received the ACA 2023-24 fees for next year and these fees have seen a larger increase over last season (between 10% to 30%). The fee increases are due to a number of factors, inflation being one, and increased insurance costs being another.

ACA has always planned on a small inflation increase year over year (1% to 2%), but the inflation rate that has occurred this season was much larger than predicted (currently 6.7%). ACA has increased their inflationary amount to 5%, AASA has also increased our inflationary rate by 4% for this coming season.

Insurance costs have continued to go up, so in an effort to reduce the deductible for this coming season ACA had to increase the premium amount by amounts ranging between \$5.00 to \$25.00, depending on what category the member is registered in.

These increases are reflected in the AASA Fees Structure for 2023-24.
