



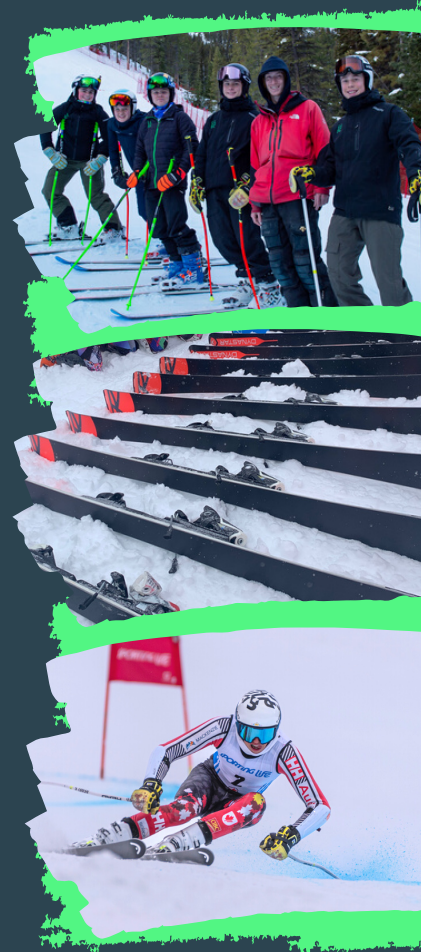

Candidates can expect to be on snow five days per week between Calgary and the Bow Valley, and travel for races is required

- Alpine Canada Alpin – Canadian Ski Coaches Development Level Trained (or equivalent) with membership in good standing
- Past alpine ski racing background and big mountain skiing skills are a requirement
- Aptitude in other area such as sport psychology, strength & conditioning are an asset
- Strong working relationships within AASA or other PTSOs, ACA are an asset
- Ability to act as a RISE Ambassador of the LLSCs and help build a positive team environment
- Excellent leadership, teamwork and communication skills
