The Alberta Masters Ski Club (AMSC) is seeking a motivated, energetic, and organized alpine ski coach to join our dedicated coaching team for the 2025 season. Our Masters program serves a diverse group of adult athletes—ranging from former competitive racers to those new to alpine ski racing—ages 18 to 80. We are a "Sport for Life" program focused on skill development, camaraderie, and a lifelong love of skiing.

Position Overview

This is a part-time, weekend coaching role based at Nakiska Ski Area. The successful candidate will:

- Coach adult athletes on Saturdays and Sundays
- Deliver on-hill training, video review, course setting, and athlete feedback
- Work independently when required, while collaborating closely with our Head Coach, Claudio Berto
- Foster a positive, safe, and engaging training environment

This position reports to the AMSC Board of Directors, with direct coaching oversight and mentorship by Head Coach Claudio Berto. Claudio has over 45 years of coaching experience with level 3 certifications in CSC, CSIA and NCCP. While the role is seasonal, there is potential for annual renewal.
