

Mandatory Implementation of Alberta's Fairness and Safety in Sport Act

Alberta Alpine is required to comply with the Government of Alberta's **Fairness and Safety in Sport Act** and associated regulations effective September 1, 2025.

As a Provincial Sport Organization (PSO), Alberta Alpine must implement and administer these requirements as mandated by provincial legislation. Compliance with the Act is required for Alberta Alpine to maintain its status and operations within the province.

Who the Act Applies To

The legislation applies to athletes who:

- Are **12 years of age or older**
- Are **residents of Alberta**
- Are participating in a **female-only competitive category**

What Is Required

Athletes competing in female-only competitive categories will be required to acknowledge during the registration process that they were female at birth, as indicated on their birth registration documents.

What Is Not Affected

This legislation does **not** apply to:

- Male-only competitive categories
- Athletes under 12 years of age
- Out-of-province or international athletes
- National or international competitions
- Training, practices, camps, or day-to-day programming
- Non-competitive activities and events
