Are you looking for an exciting and adventurous opportunity to work with an exceptional group of alpine ski athletes in the north of the North Zone?

Our coaches are responsible for the implementation of successful and safe NGSL and Regional programs and support the Head Coaches/Program Director in implementation of the Season Plan.

A minimum qualification for the position is CSC Entry Level Trained for NGSL and CSC Development Level Trained for Regional athletes (U14/U16/U19) however relevant experience will be considered if you have the ability to achieve Development Level status. Annual Licensing is required. CSIA training is complementary and encouraged, but not mandatory.

Duties of the Coach

On Snow Training and Preparation

- With input from the Program Director and/or Head Coach, plan and design athlete on snow training programs with the other coaches that meets the objectives of the Snow Stars program.
- Assist Program Director and/or Head Coach to help organize training camps
- Run on hill training sessions
- Conduct athlete video analysis – as required for the age categories
- Oversee and ensure on hill safety measures

Competition Program

- Be knowledgeable about the rules and regulations that govern alpine ski racing
- Attend team captain/race meetings as required
- Set race courses for ROCs as required
- Provide input to the Program Director and/or Head Coach for athlete development and goal setting
- Participate in coach meetings with the Program Director and/or Head Coach as set, to ensure understanding of the goals to be achieved in support of the program
- Provide constructive feedback to racer and parents

Equipment

- Assist the Program Director and/or Head Coach with the club equipment manager to identify equipment purchase and maintenance requirements
- Advise racers/parents regarding skis, boots, goggles, clothing, ski tuning tools, etc.
- Ensure athletes/parents are aware of how to prepare skis for races and ensure skis are prepared suitably for the race by the athlete (appropriate for the level of competition and maturity of the athlete).

Administration

- Assist the Program Director and/or Head Coach with the selection and awarding of club/athlete awards
- Manage personal/club expenses for the club activities/races/camps

General Communications

- Maintain and foster good relations between other (North Zone) club coaches
- Maintain open communication with skiers, coaches and parents to ensure a trusted and enjoyable team environment

Additional Information

- Competitive seasonal wages offered based on qualifications, travel benefits for racing events
- The team trains at Vista Ridge All Seasons Park, which offers 8 trails and 2 quad chairs
